This is an old traditional dance, original source unknown. Elinor learned the dance in school in England.

"A Call from the North," The Wick Scottish Dance B_and , E.M.I. Talisman STAL 5029. Side 2, Band 4. RECORD:

Round the room cpl dance. Dance can be done continuously FORMATION:

with the same ptr or progressively with a new ptr. Dancers face LOD with nearer hand joined. W on M's R.

3 steps fwd/bkwd (cts 1-3), hop (ct 4). STEPS: Schottische:

PATTERN METER: 4/4 Bars

- Leading with outside ft. do one schottische fwd.
- Do one schottische bkwd with inside ft. 2
- With cpls facine LOD, move diag away from ptr with 1 schott-3 ische. Clap on hop.
- Moving diag twd ptr do 1 schottische. End in ballroom pos. 4 If dance is being done progressively, the progression takes place at this time with the W moving diag fwd to the next M in front of ptr, while the M move in twd the W behind his orig ptr.
- In ballroom pos, move in LOD with 1 schottische. 5
- Do 1 schottische in RLOD.

Do 4 step-hops turning in LOD to finish facing LOD with 7-3 nearer hands joined.

Repeat dance from beginning.
