

Cincinnati Waltz Quadrille

(Square dance)

This dance was written by Jerry Helt and is also known as the Gibson House Waltz.

Music: 3/4 meter Blue Star BS 2378-A

Formation: Four couples in a square.

Steps & Styling: Because this is in 3/4 meter, instead of walking, dance two waltz steps during each measure or four waltz steps during each two-measure figure.

<u>Meas</u>	<u>3/4 meter</u>	<u>Call</u>
1-2	All four ladies right-hand star.	
3-4	All four ladies left-hand star.	
5-6	Turn partner with a right hand once around.	
7-8	Turn partner with left hand once and a half.	
9-10	All four gents right-hand star.	
11-12	All four gents left-hand star, and pass partner.	
13-16	Waltz/promenade the NEXT lady all the way back to the man's home position.	

Note: The "waltz/promenade" during the last four measures can either be done in ballroom position, rotating CW as a couple while moving CCW around the set, or in promenade position, moving side-by-side CCW around the set.
