With the music right and left back. KITCHEN HORNPIPE by Ralph Page 1, 4, 7, etc., couples active and crossed over. Music: Any well phrased 64 count Hornpipe or Reel. - - - , With the one below balance and swing, - - - , Put her on right and circle six, --- - - Full around. - - - . With the couple above right hand star, - - - , With the couple below left hand star, - - - . With the couple above right and left thru, ---, With the music right and left back. HILLS OF HABERSHAM BY Mary and Fred Collette 3, 5, etc., couples active and crossed over. Music: Shaw 181. ---; ---; ---; All pass thru, - - - ; - Balance right; - and left; - solo turn. - - - ; - Balance right; - and left; all pass thru, - - - ; - Balance right; - and left; - solo turn, - - - ; - Balance right; - and left; - actives down outside.
