Record: Shaw No. 3317 - 33-1/3 rpm

Formation: Circle of couples facing LOD, open position.
Footwork: Opposite throughout. Man start on left foot.

Introduction: Wait 2 meas. APART, POINT, -: TOGETHER, TOUCH, -;

Measures:

WALTZ AWAY; TURN IN; BACK UP; TURN IN; In open pos. Legin on M's L. (W's R) and waltz diag away from partner, waltz in two partner on R to brief butterfly pos. release M's R. and W's L. hand, join other hands and dance one waltz backward in LOD on L; turn in two partner with one waltz step on R and change hands again to M's R. W's L to end facing LOD in open position.

5.8 SOLO WALTZ TURN; - - -; STEP, SWING, -; STEP, SWING, -; On M's L and moving down LOD, release joined hands and sule turn once around (M L-face W R-face) with two waltz steps; facing LOD in open posistep L, swing R, hold, step R.

swing L, hold.

9-16 FILPEAT MEASURE 1-8, except on meas. 8 step R to face partner, touch L to R and assume butterfly pos. M's back to COH

BALANCE TOGETHER; BALANCE APART; CHANGE PLACES; FACE, TOUCH, -; On M's L balance together in butterfly sidecar with left hips adjacent, touch R to L balance apart on R, touch L to R; change places using 3 steps L, R, L with W passing under her R and M's L arms; step R, touch L to R to end facing partner.

21-24 REPEAT MEASURES 17-20 back to original pos with W

turning under the same joined hands.

25-28 BALANCE LEFT; BALANCE RIGHT; VINE, 2, 3; THROUGH, SIDE, CLOSE; Step to side on M's L, in back on R, in place on L (waltz balance); step to side on R, in back on L, in place on R, step to side again on L, behind on R, to side on L; step through (both XIF) on R, step to side on L, close R to L. End in closed dos. M's back to COH.

29-32 BALANCE BACK: MANEUVER; WALTZ (RF): TWIRL; Balance back on M's L, hold 2 cts; with one waltz step M maneuver his back to LOD; stepping back on L dance one R face turning waltz; twirl the W R-face under his L and her R joined hands.

Repeat the routine two times more.

ENDING: With M's back to COH and facing partner:
BALANCE LEFT; BALANCE RIGHT; TWIRL THE LADY; BOW.

In addition to this classic, fun to dance, American Round Dance, this same record has, on the 'flip-side', the music and cues for the "Double Weave Mixer", and that music is also used for TWO other dances...the Three-Quarter Time Contra...and the Minuet Mixer when a more 'lively' tune is needed to substitute for the Minuet music.
