NOTE: This dance consists of eleven figures and seven choruses. One can only learn this dance by a competent teacher since the dance contains a great deal of style and detail. To write out the details of each figure and explain the fine points would make a book in itself.

The following instructions is the order of the dance. Keep this instruction sheet handy for reference and it will help you learn the <u>HOPAK</u> more quickly

Two figures follow each chorus and be sure to start on the right foot for every figure and every chorus.

#### A CHORUS

- Figure 1 Advancing forward with Pas-de-bas steps
- Pigure 2 Lady faces man's right shoulder
  Both move counter clockwise
  While man does a reel step, lady does a toe and heel

#### B CHORUS

- Figure 3 Moving line of direction, counter clockwise, Man has left hand on hip, lady holds beads with left hand. Alternate following step Step on right foot and cut with left and take 3 steps in place ... RLR
- Figure 4 Hold right hands man has back to centre Do side step to man's right

#### C CHORUS

- Figure 5 Man places left hand out, palm up and lady places her left hand on his.

  This step is the same as the <u>Koketka</u> step but no turning Right heel to left knee, right toe to floor and take 3 steps in place ... RLR
- Figure 6 Man faces lady with back to circle
  While the man does the squat step in place the lady
  does a solo turn to her left
  She has right hand on hip and holds her beads with
  her left hand.

## D CHORUS

- Pigure 7 Hold right hands, man has back to centre
  Man starts with right foot, lady left foot
  Do a right angle step (It is also called a Charlie
  Chaplin step)
- Pigure 8 While man does the Scissors step
  The lady does half turns alternating to left and
  to right

# E CHORUS

Figure 9 Man has arm around lady's waist Lady holds skirt, with right hand and has left hand on man's right shoulder

Turn in place, man going backward and lady forward Do a leap-run-run. Alternating right foot and left foot

Figure 10 Man faces lady with back to circle Lady does toe and heel forward Man does toe and heel from side to side

### ▼ CHORUS

Pigure 11 Same as Pigure 6 While the man does the Squat step in place The lady does a solo turn to her left

G CHORUS The seventh chorus ends the dance

Except at the end of the dance we have

CHORDS STEP - Couple faces counter clockwise hold inside hand, free hand on hip start with right foot and do a Leap-Run Run Alternate right foot and left foot
