

**ROMANIAN HORA**  
("Romanian Hora")

**SOURCE:**

A Romanian circle dance, originally taught by Dick Crum and introduced at the 1966 Appalachian Folk Dance Workshop by Gordon Engler.

**MUSIC:**

Period LP-1616, Side 1, Band 9—"Hora from Pitesti". However, any Romanian Hora of moderate tempo may be used.

Meas.	Pattern
1	Step in fwd ctr of circle with L ft (ct. 1).
2	Step bk away from ctr with R ft (ct. 1).
3	Facing L and moving in this direction, step on L ft (ct. 1) and R ft (ct. 2).
4	Still moving L, step on L ft (ct. 1), turn to face R (ct. 2).
5	Facing R and moving in this direction, take a step with the R ft (ct. 1).
6	Still moving R, step with L ft (ct. 1).
7	Still moving R, take 2 steps, R (ct. 1) and L ft (ct. 2).
8	Still moving to R, step on R ft (ct. 1) and turn to face ctr of circle (ct. 2).
	Repeat Meas. 1 - 8 to end of record.

**(REMINDER INSTRUCTIONS:** Beginning with L ft, balance fwd and bwd; then take 3 walking steps to the L; then, facing R take 2 slow steps R,L, and three quick steps R,L,R, ending up facing once more fwd ctr of circle.)

This dance requires no partners. Hands are held low.
