INTRODUCTION:

PART I:1 Facing ~~R~~ ctr, step on R to R, arms move to R (ct 1); cross L in front of R, move arms to L (ct 2)2 Step R to R and lean ~~in same direction~~ ^{and face L of ctr} (cts 1, 2)3 ~~Lean to L (cts 1, 2)~~
~~Step L to L and face R of center, lean L~~PART II: (Chorus)

1 Step to R with R (ct 1); cross L in front of R (ct 2)

2 Step R, lift L (ct 1); step L, lift R (ct 2)

* For Part II, body is bent at waist and arms move in a circular motion

Words for the Chorus:

Do part I ten times, or 6 of instrumental
