KOZOK (KOH-zohk)

This is a couple dance known all over the mountainous region of Beskid in Slask (Silesia), in southwestern Poland. As in many Beskid dances, the name derives from the word koza - the goat, but has nothing to do with the word kozak: the warrior-peasant (the Cossack), or the Ukrainian dance. The music is composed of two melodies in 2/4 time. A song goes with it about a girl who loves to dance the kozok, but is very choosy when it comes to picking her future husband.

Music Record: DR-7167 and RPC-713, "Tance Slaskie" (Silesian Dances), side B, band 4, (available from Ada Dziewanowska); 2/4 time.

Starting Position: Cpls in a circle, both M and W facing LOD, holding hands with arms crossed in back.
