(Zensko - Women's) Krivoto

This dance is from the Voden-Kostur (Edessa-Kastoria) area of Aegean Macedonia. There also exists a Masko (-Men's) Krivoto, which has different music and steps.

In 2/4 rhythm. Open circle. Hands are joined, held forward at shoulder level - face center and move RLOD.

Measure

I Step on R foot to R = face center
2 Step on L across behind R. moving RLOD. Body
turns somewhat L of center.

II Step R to R (RLOD) = Body faces center.
2 Step L across in front of R (RLOD) = Face R of

NOTE: The above steps are all "soft" due to small flexing of knees on each step.

Hop forward on L foot, moving & facing RLOD. Free R leg is bent at knee and held so that R heel is near L ankle.

2 Hop forward on L.

center.

1V 1 Step forward on R. 2 Hop forward on R - L knee is bent, L heel by R ankle

V Same as IV, but reverse footwork.
