## MANITOU MIXER O

Record: Shaw Record No. 3303

Formation: Closed pos., M facing LOD (W facing RLOD). Foorwork: Starting M's L - opposite footwork throughout.

Introduction: 4 meas of 2/4 time. Wait.

Measures:

1.4 HEEL-TOE; HEEL-TOE; SLIDE, TWO; THREE, STEP - TOUCH; In closed pos., dance IN two COH as described in the dance "Manitou." Note that this part may be danced in two hand facing position with newer or younger dancers.

Neprat meas: 1-4, starting M's R. dancing away from COH,

ending in original places in circle.

ALLEMANDE LEFT, GO RIGHT AND LEFT, and SWING THE NEXT. All dancers turn around to face corners. Allemand left with corners, face person with whom they danced the "Heel and Toe," join rights hands and pass by, moving in Grand Right and Left progression to pass the next person with the left hand. Swing the next (3rd) until the music starts again. Note that either a two-hand swing or a closed position swing may be used.

Note: BOTH of these dances are on the 'flip-side' of another dance given here...the "Naverick Waltz Circle Contra"...making this record especially useful!
