- ST. GILGEN FIGUREUTANZ A Marching dance with Landler figures from Upper Austria
- Record: Tanz SP 23050 (Atlantic Mixer) cen be used since the original music has not been recorded.
- Formation: Couples facing LOD, inside hands joined (M R, W L)
 Meas
- 8M Introduction used only at beginning of dance, couples march LOD continuously while doing figures.

FIG 1

8 Girlsaround boy: W walk once CCW around M returning to original position on outside of circle, M raises

Larm as W walks around him so that M R hand and W L hand end up in M L armpit when W is on outside of circle. Couple join free hands in front and continue marching LOD.

FIG 2

Boy duck out, girl turn left: M ducks out of raised four hands (no turn for M), W turns once CCW under joined hands, both now facing LOD with M R hand (WLH) on W R shoulder. M L hand and W R hand still joined and extended in front as couple continues marching LOD.

FIG 3

Window: Couple again raises four hands above heads,
W turns once CCW and ends facing LOD while lowering
her L hand (M R hand) in front of her face to form a
window of the other joined hands held high overhead
(M L, W R).

Repeat 1, 2 and 3 as often as desired.

VARIATIONS

- 1. To make a mixer of the dance during the last four meas of Fig 3 the joined hands are loosed, W moves forward quickly to M ahead of her join inside hands and do Fig 1 with new partner.
- St. Gilgen <u>Figuren Tanz</u>. This form comes from St. Gilgen, Austria.

8M Walk 16 steps LOD, couples with inside hands joined. FIG 2

8M Man wrapped (girl around boy): Same as Fig 1 in previous description.

FIG 3

Boy duck out, couple turns: Without dropping hands
M appel (quick double stamp with both feet) and duck
to allow W to move forward while pulling W hands over
his head. M stands up still holding hands which are
now crossed and couple rotates CCW leaning away from
each other, end with W on outside.

FIG 4

8M Woman wrapped: With hands still joined raise hands over W head, W turn once CCW, lower joined M R and W L hands to W R shoulder, other joined hands extended forward as couple walks LOD. On last two steps release M L and W R hands and W turns 3/4 CW to face center while M turns 1/4 CCW to face center, drop hands to end W standing behind M.

FIG 5

Man Clap:

M clap hands in any desired free style rhythm. W step

R, swing L across R, repeat L and alternate to R & L,

hands on hips.

Repeat dance from beginning, W walk faster to progress to new partner at beginning of Fig 1.
