Record: Folkraft 1485x45A and LP-5 (side B band 5).

Formation: Double circle: couples facing line-of-dance (counterclock-wise), woman on partner's right.

Starting Position: Inside elbows bent and hands joined about shoulder level, minuet style. Man's right foot free and steps described for man (woman does counterpart).
