Music 2/4 Measure

1-2 Two STEP BOUNCE-BOUNCES* sideward right.

3-4 Two PAS DE BASQUES** (left, right).

5-8 REPEAT pattern of measures 1-4 reversing direction and footwork.

Note: Measures 1-2 and 5-6 may be a simple Step-Close-Step-Touch*** instead of the more complicated Step-Bounce-Bounces.

*STEP BOUNCE-BOUNCE sideward right (): Step on right foot, bending knee (count 1), begin to close left foot to right, raising right heel (count and), lower heels twice (counts 2-and).

**PAS DE BASQUE left (). A slight leap sideward left on left foot (count 1), close and step on right foot beside left, OR cross and step on right foot slightly in front, or in back, of left (count and), step on left foot in place, bending knees slightly (count 2). Repeat, reversing direction and footwork, for Pas de Basque Right.

***STEP-CLOSE STEP-TOUCH right (JJJ): Step on right foot (count 1), close and step on left foot beside right (count 2); step on right foot (count 3), close and touch left foot beside right without taking weight (count 4). Repeat, reversing footwork, for Step-Close Step-Touch Left.
