METER: 2/4 PATTERN

1-8 INTRODUCTION:
1-8 Do ftwk of Fig. I and repeat it again in Fig. I (16 meas in all)

1-8 Do 8 sharp two-steps in LOD, beginning with R and lead with heel on ct 1 of each meas. Body is bent very slightly fwd and shldrs sway slightly in direction of leading heel.

FIG. II:
Facing ctr, step R to R (ct 1); close L to R (ct 2). Tilt body sdwd R (ct 1); straighten (ct 2).

- 2 Repeat meas 1.
- Continuing sdwd R, step R to R (ct 1); close L to R (ct &); step R to R (ct 2).
- Brush L fwd (ct 1); bring L back twd R do not brush ft bkwd (ct 2).
- 5-7 Repeat meas 1-3 with opp ftwk and direction
- 8 Stamp R twice (no wt) and bend body slightly fwd with each stamp (cts 1-2).

Repeat dance from Fig. I. Music ends with Fig. I, and instead of the last two-step, end with a stamp fwd on L.
