Meas Pattern

> INTRODUCTION. Varies with the recording.

I. LA RASPA (Done in place)

1 Leaping onto L, extend R ft fwd, heel touching the floor (ct 1); leaping onto R, extend L ft fwd, heel touching the floor (ct 2).

2 Repeat meas 1, ct 1 (ct 1); hold (ct 2).

3-4 Repeat meas 1-2 with opp ftwk. 5-16

Repeat meas 1-4 three times.

II. SKIPS

1-8 Hooking R elbows with ptr, skip 16 steps turning CW. 9-16 Hooking L elbows with ptr, skip 16 steps turning CCW.
