FORMATION:

Open or closed circle, low hand hold.

2/4	PATTERN
Meas.	Facing slightly to R, step fwd with R ft (ct 1), hop on R (ct 2)
2	Step fwd with L (ct 1), hop on L (ct 2)
3	Step fwd with R (ct 1), Step fwd with L (ct 2)
4	Step fwd with R (ct 1), Hop of lift on R, turning to face ctr, swing L ft fwd diag to R (ct 2)
5	Step L to L (ct 1), Close R to L ft, without weight on R (ct 2)
6	Step R to R (ct 1), Close L to R, without weight on L (ct 2)
7	Turning to face slightly L, step fwd with L (ct l), Step fwd with R (ct 2)
8	Step fwd with; L (ct 1), Hop wai ATL, turning to face R, swing R ft fwd diag to L. (ct 2)
