In ancient days, skilled craftsmen, who belonged to guilds in Europe, often had their own occupational dances that they did on special holidays. The Shoemaker's Dance is of this type, and was brought to the United States in 1917 by members of the Danish Folk Dance Society.

Words to Fig I (Music A)
Song:

Wind, wind, wind the bobbin, Wind, wind, wind the bobbin, Pull, pull, Clap, clap, clap.

Wind, wind, wind the bobbin, Wind, wind, wind the bobbin, Pull, pull, Tap, tap, tap.

Tra, la, la, la, la, la, la (repeat three more times)

or

Heel and toe and away we go, Heel and tow and away we go, See my new shoes neatly done, Away we go to have some fun.

Meas Pattern

1-2 INTRODUCTION

FIG I (Music A)

- With arms bent at shoulder height and hands clenched to form fists, circle one fist over the other in front of the chest four times (winding the bobbin) (cts 1, &, 2, &).
- 2 Repeat meas 1 but reverse the action of the arms, "winding the thread" in the opp direction (cts 1, &, 2, &).

| 3 | Pull the elbows back vigorously twice to "pull and tighten the thread" (cts 1-2). |

| 4 | Clap own hands three times (cts 1, &, 2). Hold (ct &). |
| 5-7 | Repeat meas 1-2, Fig I. |
| 8 | Tap own fists together three times to "drive the peg" (cts 1, &, 2). Hold (ct &). |

| | Variation for Fig II (Music B) |
| 1 | Pts face LOD (CCW) and join inside hands. Place heel of outside ft fwd (ct 1). Place toe of outside ft in back (ct 2). |
| 2 | Starting with cutside ft, run fwd three steps (cts 1, &, 2). Pause (ct &). |
| 3-4 | Repeat meas 1-2 of variation but start with inside ft. |
| 5 - 8 | Repeat meas 1-4 of variation. |
