SOURCE: The mainland syrtos is the most ancient of all Greek dances, mentioned by Homer in his writings. It is referred to by many writers as the most significant Greek dance, in which all Greeks, now as then, participate spontaneously and with ease. This basic form also makes up the basic structure of most Greek circle dances.

4/4 sqq W hand hold

PATTERN

- 1 Step R to R (facing ctr.).
- 2 Step L behind R.
- 3 Step R to R, turning to face LOD.
- 4 Step L LOD.
- 5 Step R LOD.
- 6 Step L LOD.
- 7 Step R LOD, turning to face ctr.
- 8 Step L over R leaving R in place.
- 9 Step on R.
- 10 Step L to L.
- 11 Step R over L leaving L in place.
- 12 Step on L.
