

TIGANEASCA DIN GIUBEGA

Muntenia, Romania

Tiganeasca din Giubega means little gypsy-like dance from Giubega.

Record: Roemeense Volksdansen, Nevo 15012, Side 1, Band 6.

Music: 2/4, no introduction

Formation: Open or closed circle of men and women with joined hands held down in "V" position.

<u>Meas</u>	<u>Pattern</u>
	<u>PART I</u>
1-2	Moving R and facing diag R, dance 2 two-steps turning to face diag to L on last count (ct 1&2, 2&2).
3	Step fwd in LOD R, L (ct 1,2).
4	Step fwd R (ct 1), hop R (ct &). Step fwd L (ct 2), hop L (ct &).
5-6	Repeat actions of meas 3-4.
7	Turning to face diag R, step R (ct 1). Step L (ct 2).
8	Hop L (ct 1), hold (ct 2).
9-16	Repeat action of meas 1-8.
	<u>PART II</u>
1	Beginning R, dance diag fwd R with 1 two-step (ct 1,2).
2	Dance straight toward ctr with 1,2, stop (ct 1,2).
3	Dance 1,2, stop, diag fwd to L (ct 1,2).
4	Facing diag. L, step L (ct 1); step R across in front of L (ct 2).
5	Repeat action of meas 4.
6	Step L back away from ctr (ct 1); Step R diag. back to the R (ct 2).
7	Turning to face diag R, step L across in front of R (ct 1); Step R (ct 2).
8	Step L across in front of R (ct 1); hop L bringing R leg fwd (ct 2).
	Repeat meas 1-8.

Repeat entire dance from beginning
