

WALDJAEGER (Forest Hunter) or INNVIERTLER WALDJAEGER (Inn quarter)

Record: Tanz EP 58 107

Formation: Couples, regular dance position, on the line of the circle, both look in LOD, so position is slightly open.

1-4 Beginning on outside feet do four step-close steps in LOD, thus: step fwd on outside foot, bring inside foot to instep of outside foot, without putting weight on it (step-touch) and so on.

5-6 With one change-step and 1/2 turn CCW she moves toward center and with another change-step and 1/2 turn CW away from center, while he dances in place, with 1/4 turn CCW and CW.

7-8 with two polka steps couple makes one CW turn, progressing in LOD. Then the dance starts again.

The style is earthbound, very smooth with little hopping and stamping, singing, whoops and yodeling only where the dance prescribed such things.
