PATTERN Measures WALK, SIDE CLOSE, CLAP a) Ptr start on outside ft (Boy, L, Girl, R) and walk fwd 1-2 LOD 4 steps. b) Ptr move swd away from each other (Boy, L to ctr, 3-4 Girl, R to wall), dancing 2 side-close steps, thus forming 2 circles approx. 4 feet apart; however, dancers are still facing LOD. c) Ptrs walk forward LOD 4 steps in separate circles (Boy 5-6 inside, Girl outside), both hands at waist. d) Turn to face ptr (Boy 1/4 turn R, girl 1/4 turn L), 7-8 and walk 4 steps to meet ptr, clapping own hands as each step is taken. As ptrs come together, join R hands shldr high for next fig. II. RIGHT HAND AROUND WITH WALK BRUSH a) With R hand joined (free hand at waist) and staring with 9-10 Boy's L, Girl's R, partners walk CW half-way around each other with 3 steps and a brush. Partners are now in opposite places. Repeat Fig. II (a), meas 9-10 back to own place. (Boy is 11-12 now facing LOD; Girl is facing RLOD). 13 b) Partners jump once in place, clapping own hands once, simultaneously, with the jump. Jump once making a half turn right (Boy is now facing 14 RLOD; Girl is facing LOD). Clap own hands simultaneously with the jump. Partners jump three, making a 1/4 turn to own left to face 15-16
