ZETSKO KOLO Montenegro

ZETSKO KOLO is one of the many Montenegrin dances which employ group singing instead of musical accompaniment. Dance may remain at a continual slow pace or accelerate, depending on tempo of the singing. All arms on neighbor's shidrs, dance progressing to the right:

- (1) Step R with R ft.
- (2) Step L ft across & in front of R ft.
- (3) Step R with R ft.
- (4) Close L ft to R ft, or swing it across.
- (5) Step L with L ft.
- (6) Swing R ft in back of L ft.

(This dance, sometimes after dozens of verses, is usually followed by the "SKOKI", a Pair Dance.)
