**SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND APPLICATION FORM**

Federation scholarships are offered to support the growth of international folk dance. Applications are encouraged from individuals who have demonstrated their prior commitment and future potential to support the growth of international folk dance by any combination of the following: dedicated participation in their member club, serving in a specific role in their member club, logistical and administrative support, teaching dances, engaging in community outreach to promote folk dancing, etc.

**Eligible Activities and Scholarship award amounts:**

- Folk Dance Camps - Up to one-half the camp tuition.
- Folk Dance Festivals with Teaching - Up to the full registration fee.

**Post-Participation requirement:** Scholarship recipient is expected to provide tangible service to the folk dance community following the scholarship-sponsored event. This may include teaching dances learned at the event, serving in a role in local clubs, serving in a role in the Federation, e.g. serving on the Federation council, the Scholarship Committee, etc.

**Application deadline: May 15, 2024.** Awardees will be notified by June 15, 2024. If the camp fees have not been published by May 15, please estimate based on available information, such as the fee from the previous year.

You may also submit a scholarship application for a camp that takes place January - April 2025, if there has been official notification published by the host organization.

**Instructions for applying:** Provide the following information in a Microsoft WORD or pdf format document:

- Applicant's Full name
- Email Address
- Mailing address
- Phone number
- Camp or Teaching Festival for which you are seeking support.
- Cost of camp or teaching festival
- Statement describing why you want to attend and how attending will help you to continue supporting the folk dance community.
- Brief statement by your Federation Club in support of your application. Include the name of your club and the representative writing the statement of support.
