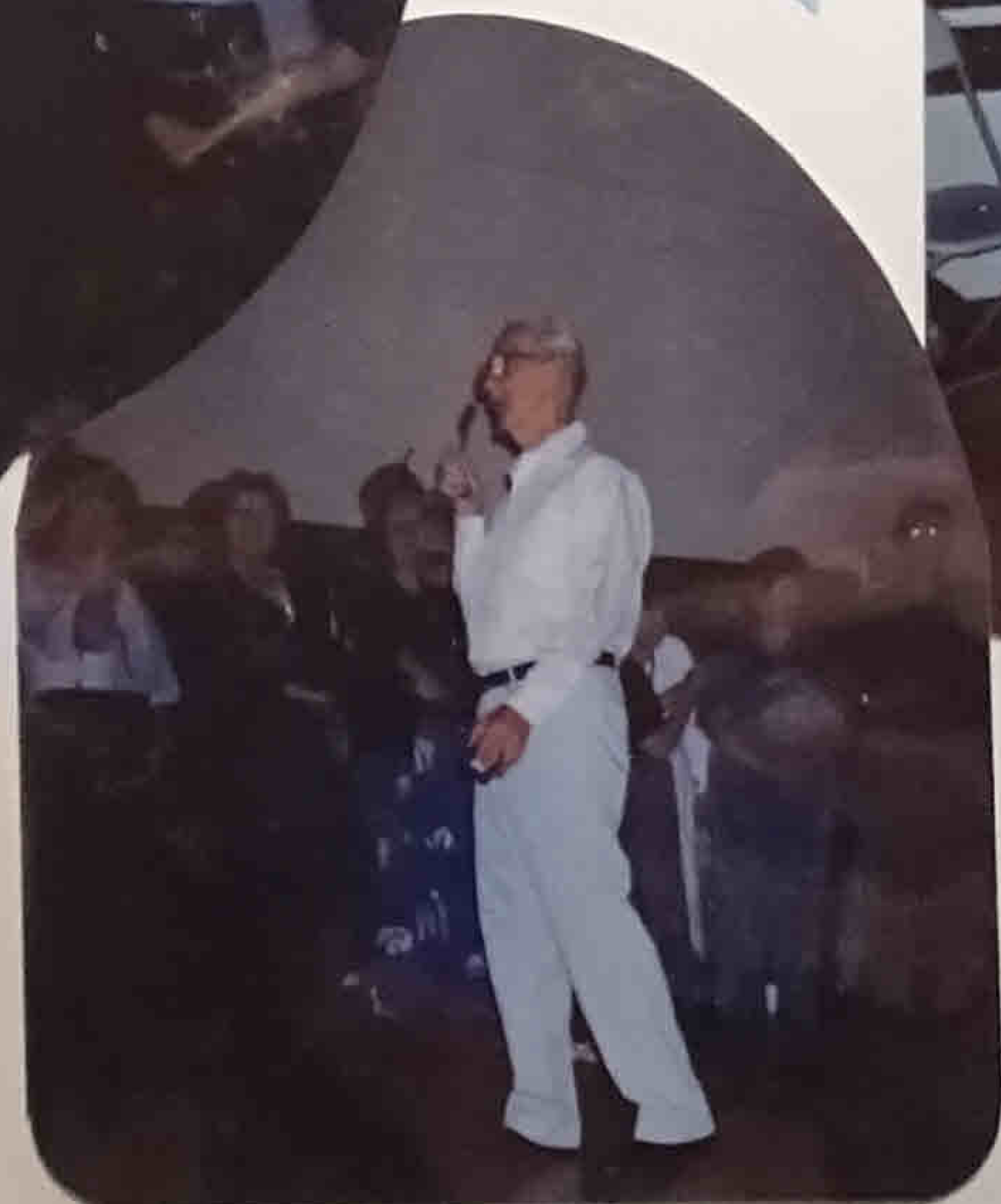
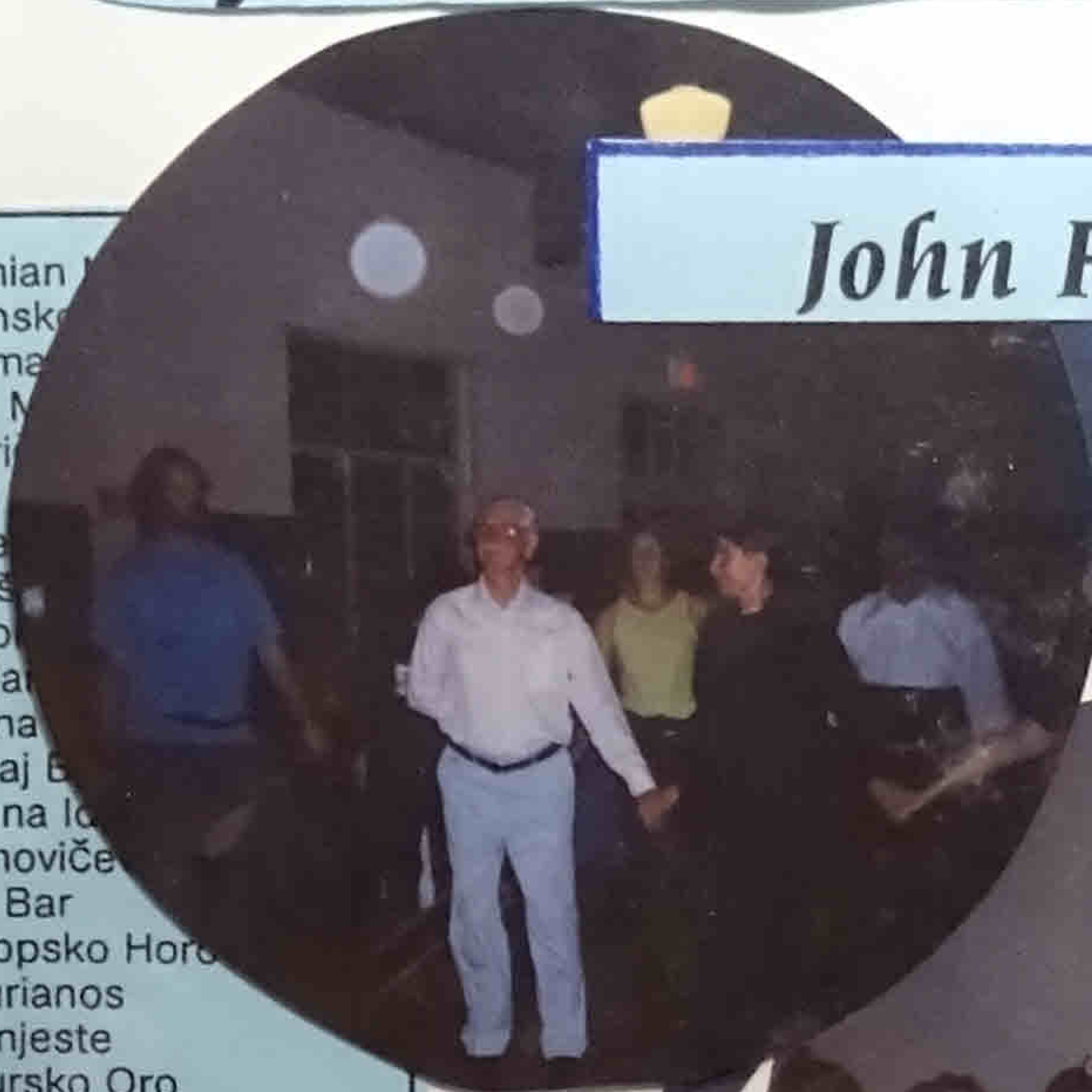

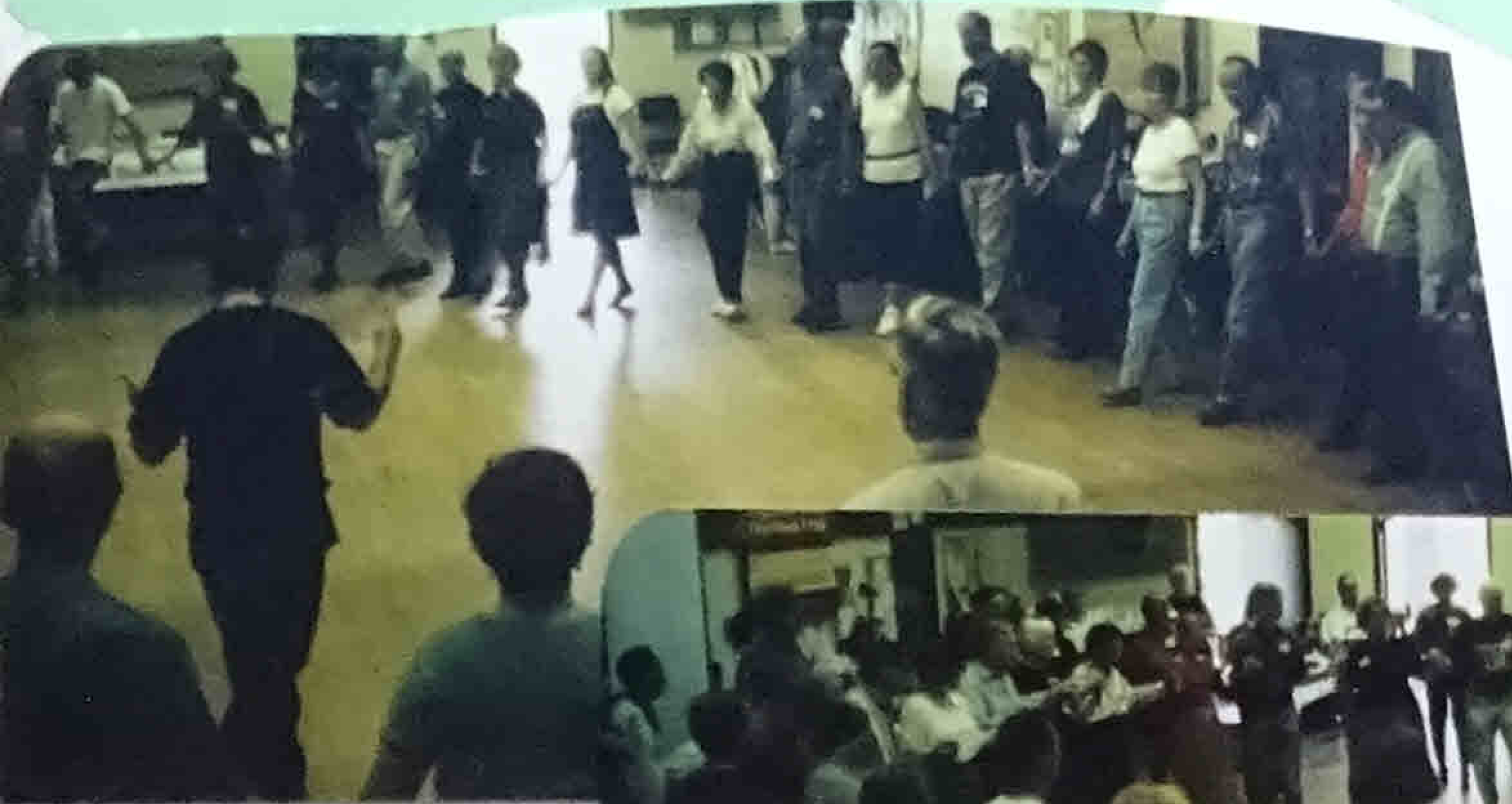
120 GUESTS- MANY IN COSTUME
