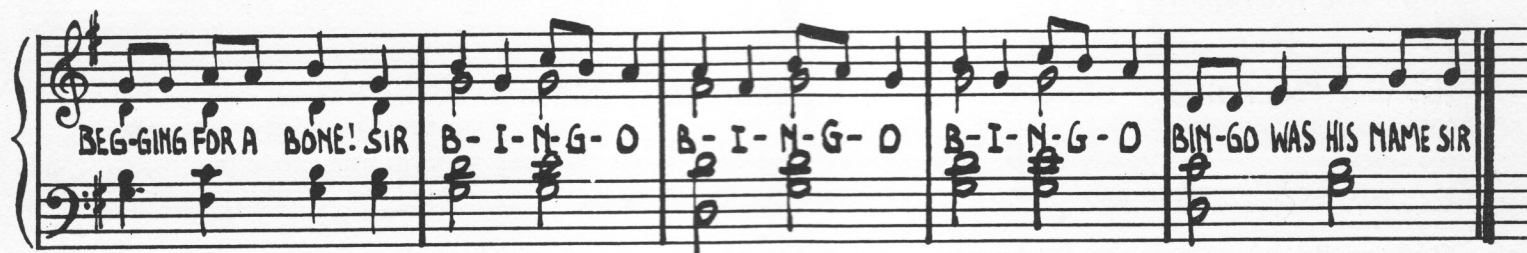
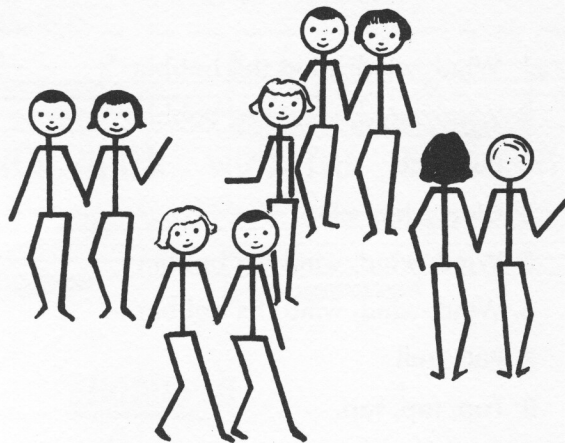


BINGO (Scotland — America)

Steps

Walk, skip

Opening Formation Circle of couples facing counterclockwise, inside hands joined. One extra dancer in the center.

Measures 1-4
Lines 1-4
(Repeated)

Everybody sings. Couples walk forward counterclockwise in tempo with the music. At the word, "sir" (Line 4), all dancers in the inner circle face about and walk clockwise in tempo with the music. Outer circle walks counterclockwise.

Measures 5-8
Lines 5-8

Outer circle skips counterclockwise, and inner circle skips clockwise, in tempo with the music. At the word, "sir" (Line 8) boy takes girl nearest him, boys and girls without partners find new ones, and the dance is repeated from the beginning. The dancer left without a partner goes to the center of the circle.
