BISERKA or BOJERKA - Serbia (Pomoravlje)

BIKEPKA HITH **FANCPRA** [bet-sehr-kah; boh-yehr-kah]

(Line dance, no partners)

Translation: Pearl (a girl's name).

Record: Folkraft 1567A.

Formation: Line or open circle, no partners, leader at right end,

Starting Position: "V" position; Oh hands joined and arms forward at shoulder level. Weight on left foot.

Music 3/4 Measure

Facing slightly right with movement in line-of-dance, 1-2 14.

two slow WALKING STEPS (right, left) forward, one step per mea Id.

ddd. One TWO-STEP (right) forward. 3-4

Facing center, STEP forward on left foot (counts 1-2) and SLIDE right 5 foot to left ankle without taking weight (count 3).

STEP backward on right foot (counts 1-2) and SLIDE left foot to right 6 ankle without taking weight (count 3).

[ddd. Facing slightly left with movement in reverse-line-of-dance._ 7-8 one TWO-STEP (left) forward.

LINE-OF-DANCE: Direction of movement to the right (counterclockwise) around the dance area. REVERSE-LINE-OF-DANCE: the other direction, to the left (clockwise).

TWO-STEP (right)(d.d.): Step on right foot (counts 1-2), step on left foot beside right (count 3), step on right foot (counts 4-5) and slide left foot to right ankle without taking weight (count 6). TWO-STEP (left): same, reversing footwork.

Note: Biserks is played first on this recording, then Bojerks; these are two different melodies for the same dance. As the tempo (d=150) is relatively fast the music is sometimes written as 8 measures of 3/8 or as 4 measures of 6/8.
