## BLUE PACIFIC WALTZ - AMERICAN

3/4 (waltz) Windsor 4638 (45) Couples facing LOD, inside H's joined. Written for M. W opposite throughout.

INTRO: 4 Meas.

Step-swing away from ptnr. 1

Change places turning once (to MR, WL) with 3-step turn. 2,3 W goes in front when crossing over. Swing free foot across on ct 2,3 of Meas 3.

REPEAT with opposite footwork, turning back to place.

4,5 Step-touch together into ballroom pos. 6

7,8

2 turning waltzes, moving in LOD. REPEAT Part I. End in SOP, both facing LOD. Ι.

Step-swing fwd in LOD. II.

- Twinkle step: Step fwd R; step L,R, both turning to 2 face RLOD.
- Cross through L; step R,L to face LOD. 3

4 Step fwd - touch.

REPEAT meas 1-4 of Part II twice more (3 times total). 5-12

Step-swing forward. 13

M step on R XIF. W 3 waltzes moving around M, 14-16 "unwinding" his feet.

## CHANGIER QUADRILLE - GERMAN

Tans SP 23559

4 Cpls in squares (numbered 1,3,2,4 CCW. #1 faces music)

INTRO: Chord

I. Circle 16 walking steps to L, 16 to R.

CHORUS:

(A) Heads split sides (W go in front) and go on outside to opposite side of set; meet ptnr, join RH's and change places (like "Box the Gnat"), W turning under CCW. (Use 2 polkas + 4 walking steps to do the whole thing.) Heads R&L through (2 polkas + 4 walking steps) and rejoin circle

Note: Sides must "help"(pull) head couples as they start.

(B) REPEAT Part (A) with sides active, heads pull.

(C) Grand R&L 12 steps to meet ptnr; RH turn once around and balance away, 4 steps. Continue grand R&L; meet ptnr and turn at home place.

II. #1 Cpl: 6 polka steps around inside of set + 4 pivot steps. End back in place. #2 Cpl repeat.

CHORUS - as above.

III. #3, and then #4, REPEAT Part II. CHORUS - as above.

IV. #1, 2 Cpls polka around each other and pivot 4.

#3, 4 Cpls repeat. CHORUS - as above.

V. Circle 8 polkas to L, 8 to R.
