

BOURRÉE TOURNANTE DU PAYS-FORT

France (Upper-Berry)

Bourrée for 2 men from Upper-Berry. It was danced around the edge of a well. Learned from Pierre Panis, 1967.

Music: Record: Rythme R-4003, Side B, band 1. Meter 3/8.
PAC 4003

Formation: 2 M holding R H shoulder height.

8 meas Introduction

Figure I "Tours" (circling)

- A 1-4 Starting both with L ft, M move CW with 4 bourrée steps.
Stamp on last ct with R ft.
5-8 Change hands. Repeat meas 1-4 moving CCW.
A 1-8 Repeat meas 1-8.

Figure II "Pivots" (turning)

- B 1-2 Drop hands. Moving individually on the line of direction.
(CCW), each M moves fwd with 2 bourrée steps.
3-4 With 2 bourrée steps each M turns CW on the spot.
5-8 Repeat meas 1-4, Fig. II.
B 1-8 Reverse direction and repeat meas 1-8, Fig. II moving CW
and pivoting CCW.
Repeat from beginning.
