(France)

Bourree for 2 W and 1 M, from upper-Berry. La Chapelottee is a small "bourg" located at 9 km north of Henrichemont (cher). Learned from Pierre Panis during the summer 1964.

Record: BAM 267, Side B, Band 3. 3/4 meter.

Formation:

2 W and 1 M form a trio. M is facing W 1, 4 ft apart. Same distance between

W2 and M.

PART I - Avant-deux

A 1-4

M and W 2 starting with L ft do "epingle a cheveux" steps, keeping the same distance between them. W1 go bkwd with the 3rd and 4th meas of "avant-deux droit", then go fwd with the 1st and 2nd meas of "avant-deux droit" remaining face to face

with M 5-8

Repeat meas I-4, Part I.

1-8 (repeat) Repeat meas 1-8, Part I.

PART II - Tours

B 1-4

Starting both with L ft, M and W 1 join R hands and do one turn CW using 4 bourree steps.

5-8

W 1 keeps moving in a small circle as W2 and M join L hands and turn CCW with 4 bourree steps.

1-8 (repeat) Repeat meas 1-8, Part II. M faces W 2 at the end of the sequence.

NOTE: Repeat from the beginning, W2 doing W1 routine, and W1 doing

W2 footwork.

NOTE:

When W has been turned CW by M she circles alone in a CCW direction. When turned CCW by M she circles alone in a CW direction.

Dance is done 3 times in all.

During the final music M kneels R between ptrs who kiss him on closest cheek.
