BOURREE DE LA BRANLE D'ARDENTES (France - Berry)

This dance is an interesting variation on basic bourrée steps. Once the dancers have mastered the pattern, the dance can be done in a large circle.


Pronunciation:

Record: Rythme 4001 (45) or F.A.C. 4001. 2/4 meter.

Formation: Quadrette - one cpl facing another cpl.

1-8 (repeat) Repeat action of meas 1-8.

Meas	Pattern
4 meas	INTRODUCTION.
A 1-2 3-4 5-8 1-8 (repeat)	Part I. Avant-Deux. Starting with L ft, all move to ctr of quadrette with two avant-deux steps (bouncing two-steps). Back away with the same steps. Repeat action of meas 1-4. Repeat action of meas 1-8.
B 1 2 3-4 5-8	Part II. Around the corners. All move diag fwd R with one bourree step. All turn L (CCW) with one bourree step. With two basic steps, all move out to the next corner. Repeat action of meas 1-4.



Note: When done in a circle, all move to the next place in LOD.
