

BOURRÉE DE LA BRANDE D'ARDENTES (this is the correct spelling)

Interesting variation on basic Bourrée steps. Once the dancers have mastered the pattern, the dance can be done in a large circle.

Music: FAC 4001 (45 RPM) 2/4 meter.

Formation: Quadrette. M have their partner on their own R.

Meas. (2/4)

Pattern

W M
M W

Music A Avant-Deux
1-2 Starting with L ft., all move to center of quadrette with 2 avant-deux steps (bouncing two-steps)
3-4 Move away from center with the same steps
5-8 Repeat meas. 1-4
1-8 Repeat meas. 1-8

Music B Around the "corners"
1 All move fwd with one basic step
2 All turn L (CCW) with one basic step
3-4 With 2 basic steps, all move to next corner
5-8 Repeat meas. 1-4, music B
1-8 Repeat meas. 1-8, music B

1st Corner 2nd Corner

WHEN DONE IN CIRCLE

Avant-deux-
all move fwd as described

Around the corners-
all move to the next place on own R.
