MEASURES

CALL

I.

- 1 - 2 If by chance we should meet
- 3 - 4 Upon the lone prairie,
- 5 - 6 In my arms I would embrace
- 7 - 8 My darling Brown Eyed Mary.

II.

- 1 - 2 TURN your PARTNER HALFWAY round,
- 3 - 4 TURN the CORNER LADY,
- 5 - 6 TURN your PARTNER ALL THE WAY round, and
- 7 - 8 PROMENADE THE FORWARD LADY.

DANCE

FORMATION-

Circle of couples, facing counterclockwise,
Woman on partner's right side.

STARTING POSITION-

Promenade position, hands crossed in front,
right hands joined over left.

Note: Each man will find his Corner lady in
the couple behind him; the Forward lady is
the lady in the couple ahead.

MEASURES

I.

- 1 - 8 Couples sing and promenade counterclockwise
with Walking steps or Two-steps.

II.

- 1 - 2 RIGHT-HAND SWING with PARTNER HALFWAY
around, exchanging places,
- 3 - 4 LEFT-HAND SWING with CORNER, finish facing
partner,
- 5 - 6 RIGHT-HAND SWING with PARTNER ALL THE
WAY around, finish facing counterclockwise,
- 7 - 8 MEN PROMENADE NEW PARTNER, the Forward
lady.

Repeat entire dance with new partner.
