	Intro: 2 meas - "charango" instrumental - start with main melody
	1. Part A - Sideways and hand claps
1	Facing partner, moving sdwd R, three steps R-L-R (1-3) touch L ft
•	next to R, while clapping both hands together up and slightly R (4)
2	Repeat action of meas. 1 in reverse direction to face partner (L-R-L) and clap both hands together slighly L and leaning fwd
3-4	Repeat action of meas 1-2
	Note: It is also possible to turn on cts 1-3 (CW to R and CCW to L)
	2. Part B - Towards partner and back
1	3 steps fwd, R-L-R twd partner ending up R shldr to R shldr (1-3)
	snap fingers, arms up (4)
2	Move away from partner three steps, L-R-L (1-3) point R ft next to L ft, while clapping hands slightly L and leaning fwd (4)
3-4	Repeat action of meas 1-2
	3. Partie C - Cross over
1	Three steps fwd twd partner (R-L-R) passing R shidr (1-3) point L ft next to R while facing partner (this forms a single line of dancers in the set) at same time snapping fingers (4)
2	Each partner turns out to L and away from partner (CCW) with three steps L-R-L (1-3) touch R ft next to L, while clapping both hands together slightly Yo L, and bending fwd (4)
	Danse repeats from the beginning (each new time on a different side of the set)
