Formation: Lines of cples, ptnrs facing, standing about 6 ft apart. Ople closest to music or caller is head cple, or first cple. When lines face front, M's line is to L of W's line. Simplified version can be done 5 times through with this record. Lines should have at least 6 cples, and as many as 10 or 12 cples. Meter: 4/4, Intro: 2 chords. Meas Description

- FWD & BOW. Take 3 steps fwd (1-3). M bows, W curtsies (4). 1
- Back away from ptnr 3 steps, and close (5-8). 2
- 3-4 Repeat FWD & BOW, and BACK TO PLACE.
- 5,6 RIGHT ARM TURN. With 8 steps, link R arm with ptnr. Make one complete CW turn, ending back in original place (1-8).
- LEFT ARM TURN. Link L arm with ptnr. Make complete CCW turn 7.8 with 8 steps (1-8).
- TWO HAND TURN. Do two hand CCW turn with ptnr, 8 steps (1-8). 9,10
- 11,12 DOCEY DO. W place hands on hips, or hold skirts. M cross hands in front of chest. Walk around ptnr, passing R shldrs and returning to place backing up passing L shldrs 8 steps.
- 13,14 Head cpl\* with two hand hold, slide 8 slides down the center.
- Head cpl slides back to place with 8 slides. (called "Sashay"). 15,16
- All face front. CAST OFF & FOLLOW THE LEADER. Man 4 turns L. to face ft of line. W 1 turns R to face foot. Men's line follow M 1, marching around to ft of set. W's line follows W 1 marching around to foot of set. M 1, and W 1 face each other joining both hands held high to make an arch. Rest of dancers go through the arch and back to places in line, except that each cpl now has moved up one place. CAST OFF, & MARCH AROUND AND BACK TO PLACES takes about 32 cts to complete. If dancers get done too soon, they can clap hands while waiting for rest of line to get back to places.

\*To vary the dance, caller can send the first two cples down the set for the sashay, and then have the first two cples make the arches. If the caller wishes, he can then have 3 cples sashay and make the arches, and keep increasing the number of cples doing this each time.

With simplified form, dance can be done 5 times through with enough music left to repeat the fwd and bow figure.

VIRGINIA REEL, with REELING ACTION. FOR 6 COUPLES TO SET. Same as simplified version for first 16 measures.

Cpl 1 does R arm turn, 1½ times around with 8 steps. M 1 ends facing W 2. W 1 ends facing M 2 (1-8).

M 1 does L arm turn with W 2. W 1 with M 2. 4 steps (1-4).

Cpl 1 meets in ctr for R arm turn, 4 steps (1-4).

Cpl 1 repeats action of L arm turn with cpl 3, and R to ptnr.

Cpl 1 repeats action of L arm turn with cpl 4, and R to ptnr.

Cpl 1 repeats action of L arm turn with cpl 5, and R to ptnr.

Cpl 1 repeats action of L arm turn with cpl 5, and R to ptnr.

Cpl 1 repeats action of L arm turn with cpl 5. 17, 18
