PART Ib - Grapevine steps (Music A) Eight GRAPEVINE STEPS\*\* (right) sideward left in line-6-13 of-dance, except at the very end of the last step: Stamp on left foot (count 2), close and stamp on right foot beside left (count 3), pause, freeing right foot (count 4). PART Ic - Step-close (Music interlude) Four STEP-CLOSES (right) sideward in reverse line-of-14-15 dance. PART Id - Soldado (Music B) 16 Four sliding or shuffling steps diagonally backward left toward center starting with right foot. Four sliding or shuffling steps diagonally forward left 17 away from center starting with right foot. REPEAT pattern of measures 16-17 three more times 19-23 (4 times in all) except, at the very end of the last time: Stamp on left foot (count 2), close and stamp on right foot beside left (count 3), pause, freeing right foot (count 4).

As Ib above: REPEAT pattern of measures 6-13.

## PART Ha

As Ia above. Finish facing partner and release hands: man clasp hands behind back and woman hold skirt out to side.

### PART IIb - Pas de Basques & turn (Music A)

6-7 Cross and rock on right foot in front of left, raising left foot off the floor (count 1), rock back on left foot in place (count 2), close and step on right foot beside left (count 3), and REPEAT, reversing footwork (counts 4-6), then two walking steps (right, left) turning left once around while progressing in line-of-dance.

8-13 REPEAT pattern of measures 6-7 three more times (4 times in all) except, at the very end of the last time:

Stamp on left foot (count 2), close and stamp on right foot beside left (count 3), pause, freeing right foot (count 4).

#### PARTS IIc, d

14-23 As Ic, d above. Finish facing partner, inside elbows bent and hands joined at shoulder height, man's left hand behind back and woman's right hand holding skirt.

PART IIe — Grapevine steps, woman turn

24-31 As Ib above, progressing in line-of-dance with GRAPEVINE STEPS except, every other measure (instead of her
2nd, 4th and 6th grapevine steps), woman turn clockwise
twice around under joined hands with four walking steps
starting with right foot.

PARTS IIIa-d and e

1-31 As Ia-d above; also as Part Ie except, during the grapevine steps, inside hands joined instead of ballroom position.

\*STEP-CLOSE (Right)( ): Step on right foot (count 1), close and step on left foot beside right (count 2), Step-Close (Left): same, reversing footwork.

\*\*GRAPEVINE STEP (Right)( ): Cross and step on right foot in front of left (count 1), step sideward left on left foot (count 2), cross and step on right foot in back of left (count 3), step sideward left on left foot (count 4).
