Formation: Mixed lines of men and women, hands joined down.

Meas Ct The Dance

Start with weight on L foot, facing center

- 1 1 Hop on L
  - Step diagonally forward L on R in front of L 2
  - 3 Hop on R
  - 4 Step diagonally forward R on L foot
    - Turning to face slightly R, Step to R on ball of R foot
- 2 1 Step on L behind R
  - 2 Step to R on R foot
  - Step on L behind R 3
  - 4 Step to R on R foot
  - Turning to face R (line of direction) Hop on R 1
    - 2 Step forward on L
    - Step forward on R 3
    - 4 Step forward on L
- 1 Turning to face center Hop on L
  - Step slightly back on R 2
  - Step on L beside R 3
  - Step on R beside L 4
- Hop on R in place 1
  - 2 Step slightly back on L
  - 3 Step on R beside L
  - Step on L slightly forward
