## DANISH SCHOTTISCHE

The following version was presented by Amy Johnson (Danish), a former teacher of dancing in Denmark.

MUSIC: Record: Folkraft 1172, M 102 (Methodist)

Piano: Any Danish schottische written in eight measure phrases.

FORMATION: Partners side by side (double circle) facing counter clockwise.

STEPS: Schottische step, step-hop.

MUSIC: 4/4

Measures	Pattern
A	I. Schottische Forward
1-2	With hands grasped in *skater position take two schottische steps forward, starting with the L. foot.
3-4	Continue with 4 step hops.
5-8	Repeat action taken to meas. 1-1.
В	II. Schottische Sideward
1-2	Partners with hands on hips, face each other and take one Schottische step to own L, returning with one schottische step to R.
3-4	Partners join R. hands, L on hips and make on turn with 4 step-hops.  Repeat action taken to measures 1-4, Part II.
С	III. Around partner
1	Partners with hands on hips face each other and move to own L with one schottische step.
2	Partners pass back to back with one schottische step to change places.
3-4	Each move back to original places with four step hops turning (LRLR).
5-8	Repeat action taken to meas 1-4 Both now have L foot free and resume skater position to repeat the dance from the beginning.
