Open circle or chain of dancers, mixed male and female, hands joined at about shoulder height

and a bit forward (W-pos) during Part I, and down at sides (V-pos) during Part II.

	(nah,) Touch L ft slightly fwd of R ft (ct 2).
3	(carne) Step sdwd on L slightly to L (ct 1).
	(oči) Touch R ft slightly fwd of L ft (ct 2).
4	(i-) Step sdwd on R slightly to R (ct 1).
	(ma,) Touch L ft slightly fwd of R ft (ct 2).
5-8	Repeat meas 1-4 to L with opp ftwk.
	<u>PART I</u> I
	Facing slightly R of ctr and moving to R (CCW), and bringing joined hands down to sides in
	V-pos:
1	(Da me)Step sdwd on R (ct 1).
	(oče) Close L ft beside R and bounce twice in place, heels not touching ground (cts 2,&).
2-4	Repeat meas 1 three more times (total of four).
5-8	Repeat meas 1-4 to L with opp ftwk.
