The Plum Pickers' Waltz

The dance given here is reconstructed (phrasing, etc.) from a traveler's description (Mrs. A. R. Thompson) of a gathering at an inn celebrating on their pay for plum-picking. The locale is some-place in what would now be southern Czechoslovakia. They distill Slivowitz, a variety of liquid dynamite from the fermented plums. Any evenly phrased Slovenian (or Croatian) waltz may be used; we have been using Sonart record No. M-2025 "Sinoc Si Meni Rekla".

Formation: Couples in closed waltz position, arranged in a circle around the room.

Α.	All waltz, closed position Bars 1-S
B	Right hands joined, lady twirls (CW) under the raised
	arms progressing (CCW) around the room. The man's
	step is a forward waltz. Partners honor at end of last
