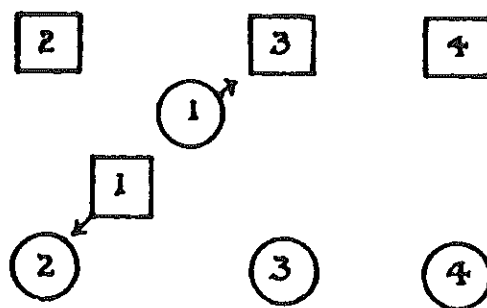

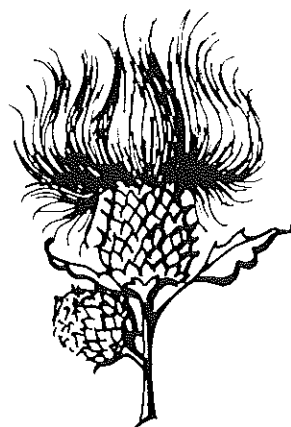


MUSIC.

DESCRIPTION.

Bars.

- 1-2 First couple turn with right hands.
- 3-4 Cast off one, *i.e.*, first woman passes behind second woman, while first man passes behind second man. Second couple move up.
- 5-8 First couple turn each other with left hands.
- 9-10 First couple turn corners with right hands (woman turns second man, while man turns third woman).
- 11-12 First couple turn each other with left.
- 13-14 First couple turn opposite corners with right (woman turns third man while man turns second woman).
- 15-16 First couple turn each other with left.
- 17-20 Set to and turn corners (first woman sets to and turns second man. First man sets to and turns third woman). (See Fig.)
- 21-24 Set to and turn opposite corners (first woman sets to and turns third man, first man sets to and turns second woman).
- 25-30 Reels of three at the sides. (The first woman with the second and third men, while the first man reels with the third and second women).
- 31-32 Cross over to own side, one place down.
- Repeat, having passed a couple.
