

THE DUKE OF PERTH, BROWN'S REEL OR PEASE STRAE (Scottish) Triple minor set, Reel (32 Bar)

Bars:

- 1-4 First couple turn with right hands (a fast turn) and cast off one on their own sides, Second couple moves up.
- 5- 8 First couple turn each other with left hands and finish facing first corners.
- 9-10 First couple turn first corners with right hands (W turns M3, M turns W2)
- 11-12 First couple turn each other with the left, and finish facing second corners.
- 13-14 First couple turn second corners with right hands.
- 15-16 First couple turn each other with the left and finish facing first corners.
- 17-20 Set to and turn first corners, finish facing second corners, (two hand turn.)
- 21-24 Set to and turn second corners (two hand turn) launch into reel immediately.
- 25-30 Reels of three on the sides, first couple initiate by passing first corners with left shoulders.
- 31-32 Cross over onto own side, one place down, thus progressing, if there is another triple minor set, otherwise pass immediately to the bottom of the set.
