- 16 CTS OR STACT OF THE ZONS + GOT FROM THISE

 NAT Part I: In social dance posn, turn in place CCW; M takes 14 walking steps bwd starting L, and W runs fwd starting R. Then, on the last 2 counts (15 and 16), step bwd away from ptnr, M's L hand still holding ptnr's R (one step) and then twd ptnr again (one step), ending in a closer posn with M holding W's R hand in his L at his L hip; W's L is on M's R shldr and his R is on W's waist.
 - Part II: Moving CW around ptnr once each 3 counts and travelling in LOD around room, dance for 8 meas using same step as in Sønderhoning. (M step L; both; R. W step R and quickly close L to R; step R again; then take small leap onto L.)

Since in Part II one turn takes 3 counts, but the music is in 2/4 meter, 5 complete turns take up 15 of the 16 counts in the phrase. On the last count pause briefly before starting over again with Part I.
