## GREIŽ (greyzh)

## (Couple dance or mixer)

Translation: probably derived from the German word "kreuz" which means "cross".

Record: Folkraft LP-35 (side B band 7) - 1:34.

Formation: Couples facing line-of-dance (counterclockwise), woman

on partner's right.

Starting Position: Inside hands joined. Man's left foot free and steps described for man (woman opposite footwork).

Music 2/4

Measure 1-2

Three WALKING STEPS (left, right, left) forward (counts 1-3) Releasing hands, pivot half around (man right, woman left) on outside foot and TOUCH right heel forward (count 4).

REPEAT measures 1-2 moving in reverse line-of-dance. 3-4

Four WALKING STEPS in a small clockwise circle once around (woman in a 5-6 counterclockwise circle).

Four WALKING STEPS turning clockwise with partner in place in ballroom 7-8 position.

AS MIXER —

As above except, during measures 5-6, man move forward in line-of-dance to next woman ahead and turn with her as new partner during measures 7-8.

REPEAT entire dance starting with this NEW PARTNER.
