Figure 1 – 6 measures – facing center with arms held down

#### Measure 1

- 1. Leap onto the right foot across the left
- 2. Leap onto the left foot in place
- 3. Leap onto the right foot next to the left
- 4. Leap onto the left foot in place

#### Measure 2

- 1. Leap onto the right foot across the left
- 2. Leap onto the left foot in place
- 3. Leap onto right foot across the left
- 4. Leap onto the left foot in place

#### Measure 3

- 1. Leap onto the right foot to the right (leap onto the ball of the foot first)
- 2. Step on the left foot across the right
- 3. Leap onto the right foot in place
- 4. Step on the left foot next to the right.

#### Measure 4 is the same as measure 1

#### Measure 5

- 1. Hop on the left foot
- 2. Kick the right foot down (spusik)
- 3. Hop on the left foot
- 4. Leap back onto the right foot

#### Measure 6

- 1. Hop on the right foot
- 2. Leap back onto the left foot
- 3. Leap back onto the right foot
- 4. Leap back onto the left foot

# Figure 2 – 4 measures moving to the right in a circle Measure 1

- 1. Hop on the left foot
- 2. Leap onto the right foot to the right in a circle
- 3. Leap onto the left foot to the right in a circle
- 4. Leap on to the right foot to the right in a circle

Measure 2 is the same as measure 1 with opposite feet Measure 3 facing center

- 1. Hop on the left foot
- 2. Leap onto the right foot in place
- 3. Leap onto the left foot across the right
- 4. Leap onto the right foot in place

Measure 4 is the same as measure 3 with opposite feet

### Arms for figure 2

The arms start from behind and swing forward and backward once in each measure.
