Ptrs facing, M back to ctr, R hands joined, free hands on hips.

Steps:

Step swing. Waltz.

Music:

FW 8838. 3/4

Meas:

Step swing in CCW direction with joined hands following through.

1 2

Same CW.

3 - 4

Arms are swung CCW and up above W's head, and W will make

l turn in 2 waltz steps CW ending facing ptr, taking shoulder waist pos. M takes waltz steps in place while W turns.

5-8

Waltz in shoulder waist pos turning CW, progressing CCW.

The dance must be done lightly, and full of rhythm.
