TRANSLATION: Rainbow Sister (In China, young men always call their lover "young sister.")

RECORD: C.C.S 1003, Side B, Band 6

FORMATION: Cpls in a circle facing LOD, W on M's R. Hands are fown at sides and sway natural when moving. This dance is a mixer.

STYLING: When doing hand movements fingers are always closed.

INTRODUCTION	: Begin dance with singing.
Touch inside With 2 steps twd ptr to f	th inside ft take 2 light steps fwd.  heel fwd and lean back slightly.  in place starting on inside ft, make 1/2 turn  ace RLOD.  mp (M-R W-L).with wt.  1-4, with opp ftwk and direction to end facing
movement, st circle and W arc with arm move in same in direction	th M-R and W-L face slightly in direction of ep-close-step- stamp, , M moving to outside of to inside of circle (M pass behind W). M hands is fully extended from L side to R, while W hands manner from R to L. Upper body tilts slightly of hand movement. 9-10, reversing all movements.
