## JIG ARGLWYDD CAERNARFON

(Lord of Carnavon's Jig) wates

Formation:

Longways set for four couples; proper. Use walking step

except where stepping is indicated.

Music:

B2

16 Bar Reel

All face the Harp (head of the hall): Inside hands joined with partner. A1 Forward a double and back two times.

Gypsy. Partners join little fingers of right hands, arms held straight down В1 at sides, and walk around 8 steps.

Gypsy with left hands joined.

First couple Lead Thru: First couple face down, join right hands, lead A2 down between second couple, cross over, lady passing in front of partner; pass outside the set, behind third couple, and back into the set below them; join left hands with partner and cross over, passing between the fourth couple to foot of the set.

Cast the Line Up: Ladies follow the active lady, men follow the active man, up outside of set and fall into places, last couple turning outward. Couples now arranged: Harp - 1, 4, 3, 2. Two-hand turn partner once and

a half around to opposite side of the dance.

All face away from the Harp, and repeat the dance with Couple 2 leading. Each couple will lead in turn. At end of fourth time thru, all will be in beginning places.
