On the last round the 1st corners do an extra turn single Right in their new places, while the 2nd corners are moving forward to their new places. There are 2 extra bars of music allowed for this ending with a chord for honours. Note that this is only for the last round of the dance to provide a satisfactory finish.

* i.e. move forward veering Right or Left as the case may be into progressed places.
