 - 2 Turning to move CCW, take step with left foot, moving side by alda.

 - Step on left font to left (CCW), turning face to face with ۵ partner.
- Facing partner, take light leap on right foot to the right (CW). Cross left foot in front of right. 2, 3/4 5
 - - Bring right foot near the left, bending both knees, and keeping the right foot slightly off the ground, foot parallel to the floor. Head and body are kept erect.

- 17-19 Still holding right hands, with three steps, return to original 5. 3/4 places, left, right, left. Man ending on the inside, girl on the outside, face to face.
