

TIROLER TAENZE FOLGE I continued

KATZENLEITER BOARISCHER could mean cat's ladder or cat's leader and Bavarian.

Both melodies can be used for the Bavarian dance forms which are described below. You may repeat one of them constantly or interchange the patterns.

- I. FORMATION: Couples on the line of the circle, facing LOD, partners standing side by side without joining hands.
One schottisch step (change step) diagonally forward in LOD beginning on outside feet, moving away from each other
One schottisch step diagonally forward toward each other (1-2)
Take regular dance position, turn CW with four pivot steps and two turns, moving in LOD.(3-4) REPEAT.
- II. CLAPPING M TAKES ONE step-close to his left, turning away from partner, then claps hands u n d e r left knee, puts the left foot down as he c l a p s a b o v e left knee. This is the equivalent of on a schottisch step and a rather fast move. Then he turns toward partner with one schottisch step.
IN THE MEANTIME W makes one turn CW with two schottisch steps starting on outside foot. In closed hip-shoulder position dance "Dreher" that is two CW turns with four pivot steps. REPEAT
- III. FORMATION: Couples in regular dance position on the line of the circle, M with back to center.
One step-close-step in LOD, one in RLOD and "DREHER". REPEAT
- IV. FORMATION: Couples on the line of the circle, facing IN LOD inside hands joined
M makes a CCW turn and W a CW turn under joined and raised inside hands with two schottisch steps; then "Dreher" in regular dance position, two turns with four pivot steps, progressing in LOD. REPEAT.
- V. FORMATION. as in I
One schottisch step apart and one again diagonally forward for the MAN toward the next partner, as WOMAN comes back to the MAN BEHIND HER. "DREHER" with that person . REPEAT.
- VI. FORMATION AS IN I.
One schottisch step- diagonally fwd. apart and one diagonally forward to each other, (1-2) with four pivot steps turn CW, b u t o n the t h i r d step (after 1/2 turn - WOMAN IS'ON INSIDE OF CIRCLE) M lifts W,who helps by jumping up and deposits her on outside, thus completing the turn.
